Peninsula Clean Energy Authority Electric Vehicle (“EV”) Ready Program
Low Carbon Fuel Standard (“LCFS”) Credit Designation Form

Peninsula Clean Energy Authority (“PCEA”) requires all projects that are either receiving funding from PCEA, have had funding facilitated for their project by PCEA, or has been developed with technical assistance or other project support from PCEA as part of the EV Ready Program (“Program”), to delegate all claims to any Low Carbon Fuel Standard (“LCFS”) credits that will be associated with the electric vehicle supply equipment in that project to PCEA. LCFS credits designated to PCEA will support future electric vehicle community program development and investment to decarbonize San Mateo County, pursuant to California Air Resource Board (CARB) LCFS Guidance 20-03.

In compliance with CARB requirements governing LCFS credits, either,

- a. the owner of electric vehicle support equipment (EVSE) (“EVSE Owner”) or,
- b. the authorized representative of the EVSE Station Owner (“Owner Representative”)

must officially designate the LCFS credits to PCEA. This agreement shall serve as the formal declaration and designation of the LCFS credits to PCEA generated by EVSE installed at the Property Address listed below.

EVSE Owner or Owner Representative. Please complete as follows:

The undersigned, EVSE Owner or Owner Representative, hereby represents and warrants to PCEA that they are the vested owner of the EVSE stations installed at the Property Address listed below. EVSE Owner or Owner Representative represents and warrants that they have the requisite legal authority and/or express written permission to enter into this Agreement, and to perform the obligations required by this Agreement. **In addition, Owner or Authorized Representative warrants and represents that the person signing this Agreement has the requisite legal authority to bind Owner. Upon delegation of LCFS credits to PCEA, Owner or Authorized Representative agree that they will not generate credits, will inform third-party entities that the LCFS credits generated by their installed EVSE as designated to PCEA, when necessary, and will provide the EVSE usage and electricity data to PCEA for LCFS reporting pursuant to CARB sections 95483.2(b)(8), 95491 and 95491.1.**
