



Residential Energy Programs

Peninsula Clean Energy customers can save money and help the environment by participating in our programs. We provide 100% clean electricity at lower rates than PG&E and, as a not-for-profit agency, we invest our earnings into programs to help the community.



Rebates for used electric vehicles

Income-qualifying residents can get up to \$6,000 for the purchase of a used electric vehicle. All residents, regardless of income, are eligible for a rebate of up to \$1,000.

Zero percent financing

Customers who install electric appliances and energy efficiency improvements in their homes may be eligible for loans of up to \$10,000, at zero percent interest (0%) with no money down, for a term of up to 10 years, and no credit check required. To qualify, actions taken must include either a heat pump water heating or a heat pump space heating measure.

Heat pump water heater rebates

Homeowners can get a rebate of up to \$3,000 for new heat pump water heaters and electrical panel upgrades from Peninsula Clean Energy. San Mateo County residents can also qualify for rebates and support available from BayREN's Home+ program (San Mateo County).

Heat pump HVAC rebates

Homeowners can get a rebate of up to \$3,500 for new heat pump HVAC (heating, ventilating and air conditioning) and electrical panel upgrades from Peninsula Clean Energy. San Mateo County residents can also qualify for rebates and support from BayREN's Home+ program (San Mateo County).

Free home upgrades

Our income-qualified Home Upgrade Program offers an average of \$6,500 for home repairs, energy efficiency, and electrification measures.

Solar + battery backup

This resiliency program helps residents maintain power during grid outages and provides a community electric storage network that helps us move to 100% renewable energy.
